

CCHA September 10th, 2025

Attendance: Jim Rozen, Justin Giles, Keith Mages, Tony Privitera, Matt Murphy, Greg Krauza, Tom Block, Mike Mead, Cody Williams, Gary Shain.

Greetings: The Board welcomes Captains to the meeting and thanks everyone for spending the evening on CCHA issues.

Minutes Reviewed: Minutes from the July 30th meeting were reviewed. Minutes were approved.

New Business:

- Mr. Privitera discusses future spread sheet for referees. Everyone states this is a good idea. Reminders go out that captains should introduce themselves to refs and no other team personnel are to discuss calls or complain at referees.
- Mr. Privitera explains changes to time keeper & referee payments. The 1st captain to arrive to early game is to retrieve envelopes for both games for referees & time keepers and deliver all payments to the time keepers booth prior to 1st game beginning.
- An AED machine is located near the skate sharpening office. All players are encouraged to familiarize themselves with where it is located and its usage.
- Encouraging new player participation is an ongoing theme. We were reminded that the CCHA has team fees of \$3,400 and Jamestown's costs are \$5,900. Feel free to use this information as we try to recruit new talent into our league.
- Mr. Privitera suggests that Captain & Board members get their league fees waved as a thank you for organizing the league & running teams. Discussions followed: Mr. Krauza & Mr. Mages bring thoughts about the matter. It is decided to table this discussion for a later time.
- The 2025 - 26 season will consist of 20 games plus playoff games.
- Mr. Mead suggests shortening 2 minute penalties to 1 ½ minutes because we do not play 20 minute periods. After discussions and votes the CCHA will continue to use the 2 minute format to further discourage penalties.
- Mr. Block will update a goalie contact list to assist captains should replacements be needed. Mr. Giles will update current information and assist.
- Mr. Block asks for clarification of by laws on definition of players allowed in our lower or "C" division. The following is the agreed upon definition. 40 year and older players can be allowed if they have a B-1 talent level or below. Players under 40 must be of a novice talent level as is listed in the leagues Rubric as listed in the C category. All captains are encouraged to review our Rubric as we move forward. Exceptions to this will be reviewed by all captains in a gentlemanly discussion as needed.
- A vote was passed to provide modest refreshments during future board & captains meetings.
